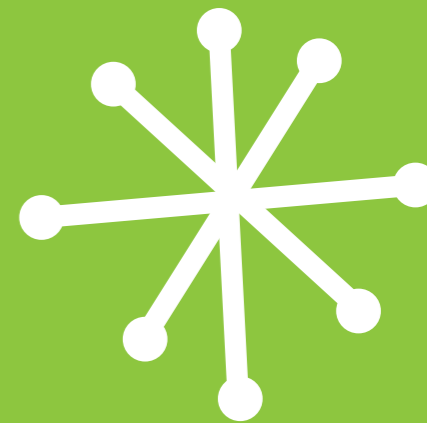
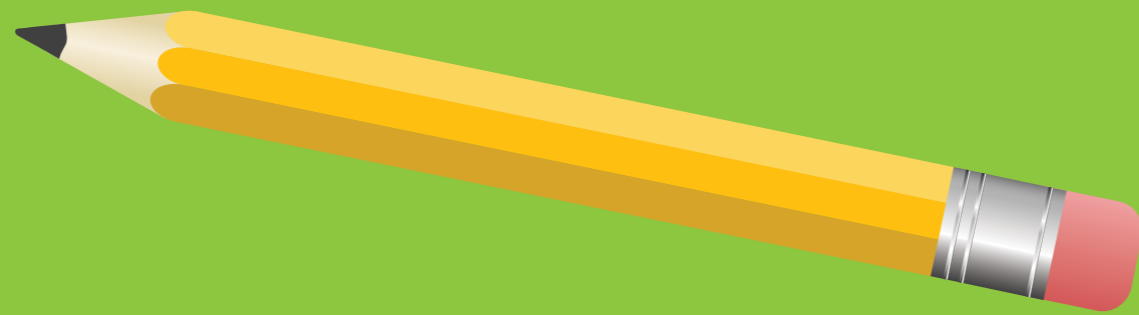

Break the word into syllables. Most often a syllable will contain a vowel.

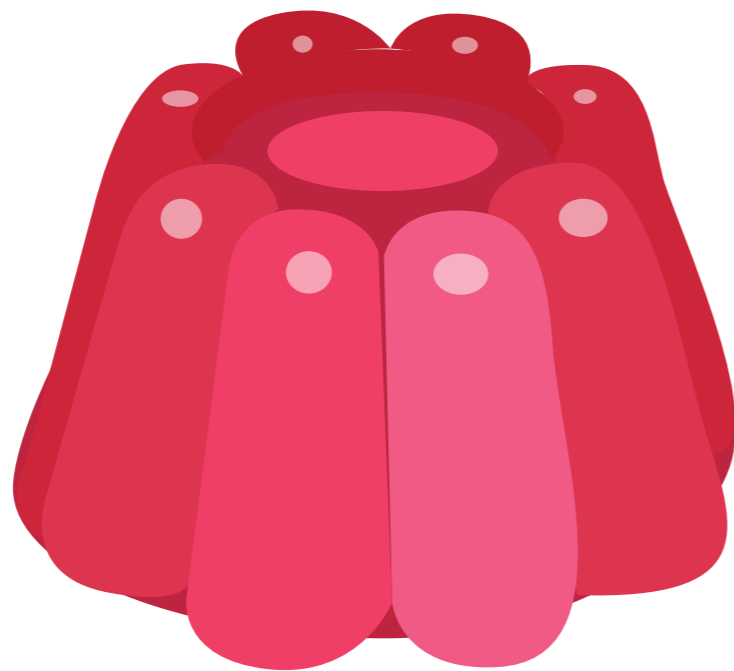
fish-ing

Ask someone next to you or the teacher for help.




Can you please help me spell this word correctly?
